PASTORAL CURRICULUM

Boys are cared for pastorally every second of their time at Harrow School through the work of their House Master, Matron, Assistant House Master, Tutor and Health Education Tutor, as well as all other Masters and Non-teaching Staff. The Pastoral Curriculum encompasses the skills and content that are delivered to enable that care. In the Lower School, Health Education Tutors take the lead in the delivery of the curriculum, supported throughout by other members of the House Team. In the Upper School, all boys follow an Advanced Health Education course that unfolds through plenary lectures and House group sessions. Conference events act as an additional layer of support, alongside a programme of presentations to parents.
