Year 9

If your son would require a scholarship and/or bursary to come to Harrow in Year 9, we recommend that you complete both the Scholarship and Bursary Application Form and the Year 9 Registration Form, and submit these to us with the £325 Registration Fee. Your son will then go through our full (standard) academic admissions process. We will then be in a better position, two years before possible entry, to advise you if he is academically strong enough to come to Harrow and what level of financial support you might be likely to receive should he win a scholarship. We will refund £200 of the £325 Registration Fee in the event that your son is not eventually offered a place at Harrow.

Alternatively, you might prefer to submit just the Scholarship and Bursary Application Form and the non-refundable Scholarship and Bursary Application Fee of £50. Your son would not then go through our full (standard) academic admissions process, but would be assessed for a scholarship in Year 8.

Year 12 (Sixth Form)

If your son would require a scholarship and/or bursary to come to Harrow in Year 12, please complete both the Sixth Form Application Form and the Scholarship and Bursary Application Form and send these to us, together with the non-refundable Scholarship and Bursary Application Fee of £50. The Registration Fee of £325 will not be required.
