

PASTORAL CURRICULUM

Boys are cared for pastorally every second of their time at Harrow School through the work of their House Master, Matron, Tutor, all other Masters and Support Staff. The Pastoral Curriculum encompasses the skills and content that are delivered to enable that care. In the Shells, this is through the Health Education Tutors in the Houses; in the Removes and Fifth Form, through Health Education Tutors, the Choices Programmes and also members of the House Team. In the Lower Sixth, the Way of Life course unfolds through plenary lectures and mixed-House group sessions. There are annual House-based social media briefings.
